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Can I use a 52v battery on a 48V motor?

Does a 48V controller use a 52v battery?

However, most of the 48v controllers and motors available today can also use 52v batteries. They both look the same but one has 4 more cells and that much more capacity and power. Takeaway: It's simple; you get more power and range with a 52v battery than with a 48V battery.

Can I use a 52 volt charger on a 48 volt battery?

No, you cannot use a 52 volt charger on a 48 volt battery. The reason for this is that the voltage of the charger needs to be lower than the voltage of the battery in order to charge it safely. What are the advantages of a 52v battery?

The advantages of 52v batteries: 52v batteries are faster. Increased voltage means increased motor RPM, and your motor will spin more quickly as the voltage increases. If you need a little extra speed or power, you've got it. 52v batteries are more powerful.

How much power does a 48v battery provide?

A 48V battery can typically provide around 1000-1500W of power, while a 52V battery can provide 1500-2000W. Of course, there are other factors that affect a battery's power output such as amp hours (Ah) and watt hours (Wh). But all things being equal, a higher voltage battery will always be more powerful.
