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Can You charge NiMH batteries off one Charger?

I wouldnt attempt to charge NiMH batteries off one charger dude, mainly due to the charger not being capable of charging NiMH in parallel or series very well...they struggle to cope with charging NiMH batteries with varying levels of discharge / capacity...which usually leads to over/undercharging in some of the batteries cells

How to charge NiMH nickel metal hydride batteries?

Unfortunately charging NiMH nickel metal hydride batteries is not as easy to achieve compared to other types of cell or battery. The NiMH cells, like NiCd's require charging using a constant current. The rate of charge is normally specified on the case of the cell and this rate should not be exceeded.

How much current does a aa/aaa NiMH battery need to charge?

Generally about charging AA/AAA NiMH batteries are usual rated for charging up to 1C, i.e. same current as their capacity. This means that a charge current of 2000mA (or 2A) for a 2000mAh battery, most chargers will charge with a lower current, but there is also some chargers that uses higher current.

Can a NiMH battery be overcharged?

3. Don't overcharge, don't under (trickle) charge NiMH batteries should never be overcharged, the maximum capacity for any NiMH battery is 120% (which is what your NiMH charger SHOULD charge your NiMH batteries to before auto shut off, @Rudd looking at you)

Can a NiMH battery be slow charged?

Slow charging NiMH batteries: NiMH battery slow charging is not to be recommended. Using charge rates of between 0.1 and 0.25C do not provide the indicators needed to detect the end of charge. With voltage changes of only about 5mV at full charge rates, the smaller changes arising for a slow charge are virtually impossible to detect.

How do you charge a NiMH battery?

Slow charge your NiMH battery the night before using on 1a current, charge until charger declares the battery full, then leave it to rest overnight....when you wake you should take the battery and charge it again, this time on 4a, for a brief period (around 20 minutes or until the battery gets hot)
