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How many kilowatts a year is wind power?

Wind power installed capacity in the country reached 490 million kilowatts at the end of November, rising 19.2 percent year on year, according to data from the National Energy Administration. Solar power capacity surged 46.7 percent to about 820 million kilowatts last month, the data showed.

How much power can a wind turbine produce?

In 1985, typical turbines had a rated capacity of 0.05 MW and a rotor diameter of 15 metres. Today's new wind power projects have a turbine capacity in the 3-4 MW range onshore and 8-12 MW offshore. The amount of power that can be harvested from wind depends on the size of the turbine and the length of its blades.

How many GW of wind power will be built in 2022?

We previously forecast 1078 GW to be built from 2022-2030, this is now forecast to be 1221 GW of new capacity added between 2023-2030. New installations (GW) Globally, 77.6 GW of new wind power capacity was connected to power grids in 2022, bringing total installed wind capacity to 906 GW¹, a growth of 9% compared with 2021.

How much wind power did China add in 2023?

According to the Global Wind Energy Council, an international trade association for the wind power industry, China added 75 gigawatts of wind power installed capacity in 2023, accounting for nearly 65 percent of new wind power installed capacity worldwide.
